On Saturday, April 28th the Chamber hosted it's 12th Annual Taste of Brooklyn "And All That Jazz" Fundraiser. I know you've all seen the emails regarding the event but I want to take a moment of your time to give some of the prior years' numbers and highlight this year's fundraiser results, Trust me, it's worth it!

The Taste of Brooklyn has always been one of the Chamber's most profitable fundraisers. 100% of the Net Proceeds from the event go right back into the community through our scholarships and teacher grants. The entire evening wouldn't be possible if it weren't for the businesses and individuals who sponsor the night, our numerous volunteers who work the event and our area restaurants who provide the food and beverages. Let's get to the fun part! In 2016 we had 225 people in attendance and raised \$6,021.46! In 2017 we increased our attendance to 245 people and raised \$6,134.72!! And true to course in 2018 we were able to keep the momentum and raise our numbers AGAIN!! We had our best year yet with 300 people at the event and we raised \$7,316.31!!!! This is almost a \$1,200 increase from 2017! HOW EXCITING! I don't know about you, but I can't wait to see what next year's event brings for us.
