The Ohio Department of Education recently released the 2013-2014 career-technical report card which includes Polaris and the state's 90 other career-technical centers. The report card includes letter grade ratings in four areas including: Post-Program Placement, Technical Skills Attainment, and Four- and Five-Year Graduation Rates. Post-Program Placement measures the proportion of students who were enrolled in post-secondary education, advanced training, military service or employed within six months of leaving high school. Technical Skill Attainment measures the proportion of students passing technical assessments related to their career-technical programs. Graduation rates measure the proportion of career-technical students who graduated within four and five years after entering the ninth grade.

Polaris earned a "B" grade with an 86.9% Post-Program Placement rate and an "A" for the 80.2% Technical Skills Attainment score. In addition, Polaris received an "A" for its 94.6% Four-Year Graduation rate and an "A" for its 95.9% Five-Year Graduation rate. Polaris also fared well in other state measures including: Industry Credentials, Academic Attainment - Reading, Academic Attainment - Math, Nontraditional Participation and Nontraditional Completion. Polaris met or exceeded target levels on all of these measures.
