Brooklyn Asked for It, They Got It! Much Desired Senior Living Community Opens in Brooklyn, Ohio

"We offer all the comforts of home without the worries associated with home ownership," Nicholas added, "which gives our residents a new freedom to enjoy life and socialize more."

Designed using new state-of-the-art technology, Brooklyn Pointe is not your typical senior living residence that exudes an institutional atmosphere. Instead, when people walk through Brooklyn Pointe's doors, they are welcomed with a homelike, residential setting flooded with natural sunlight in all areas. The two-story stone-clad community features unique architectural elements including light wells, decorative windows, and sunrooms that fill the spaces with an abundance of natural light. There is a beautiful two-story ledge-rock fireplace that towers over the lounge and neighboring bistro. Residents can be as busy as they please at Brooklyn Pointe while getting the exceptional care from best-in-class partners available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
